General

- a) This application can be used in lieu of submitting other documentation for the candidate and is only a suggested document.
- b) This application is to be used for the following St. Louis Chapter Awards: "Outstanding Engineer's" for PEI, PEG, PEE, PEC, PEPP; and Engineer of the Year for the St. Louis Chapter.
- c) Read all of the instructions carefully before preparing your form.
- d) The candidate shall be a registered Professional Engineer.
- e) The candidate shall conduct business in, teach students from, retired from practice in or resident of the St. Louis Chapter Area which encompasses the City of St. Louis and the Counties of St. Louis, Jefferson, Franklin, Warren, Lincoln and St. Charles.
- f) The candidate has not received the award in the last 10 years.
- g) The candidate shall not be a current or immediate past officer of the St. Louis Branch of MSPE.
- h) Membership in MSPE is not required.
- i) The candidate (or designee) should attempt to complete the form in its entirety. The form should be used as much as possible without attachments. If space is not adequate on the form, attachments showing continuance of a category may be submitted. Attachments should be cross-referenced with the appropriate subject. Information provided by candidates will be used to provide basis to nominate award recipient.
- j) For the winners, an electronic photo and a biography will be required for our newsletter and the award ceremony's program.
- k) Completed forms can be submitted electronically in Microsoft Word or PDF format. Submit the forms electronically to any other member of the Engineering Practices Committee.
- l) Completed forms must be received by date indicated in Newsletter.
