



MSPE Educational Foundation RSF Memorial Scholarship Application

The Missouri Society of Professional Engineers Educational Foundation will award one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to a current student enrolled in a Missouri engineering program that has been accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET-EAC). This is a competitive scholarship based upon: academic achievement; work experience; extracurricular college and/or community activities, military service and financial need. The top-scoring candidate will be awarded the “RSF Memorial Scholarship.” The recipient is chosen in the spring from a statewide competition. The scholarship is awarded after enrollment verification in the fall semester at one of these state institutions:

Southeast Missouri State University, Engineering Physics Program (BS), Cape Girardeau, MO
St. Louis University, Parks College of Engineering & Aviation (AE, EE, ME, BME), St. Louis, MO
University of Missouri-Columbia, College of Engineering, Columbia, MO
University of Missouri-Kansas City, School of Engineering, Kansas City, MO
Missouri University of Science & Technology, Rolla, MO
University of Missouri-St. Louis/Washington University Joint Undergraduate Engineering Program
Washington University, School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, St. Louis, MO

Eligible applicants ***must be*** a citizen of the United States; active U.S. Military, National Guard, Reserves, ROTC or veteran; and, a **sophomore or junior** currently enrolled in one of the Missouri ABET-EAC approved engineering programs listed above **OR** a **sophomore or junior** with plans to enroll in one of the Missouri ABET-EAC engineering programs for their junior or senior year that is currently enrolled in a Pre-Engineering Program at a Missouri College or University that has a working agreement to transfer credits with one of the schools named above.

Deadline for submittal is January 1, 2010.

Scholarship submittal package must include:

- 1) Application
- 2) Official Transcripts (must be in sealed envelope)
- 3) Two recommendations - one from an engineering professor and the other from a military supervisor
- 4) Essay on career plans not to exceed 1,000 words
- 5) Proof of military service.
