PEHE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

The PEHE Distinguished Service Award is presented to an engineering educator who has made exceptional contributions to the engineering profession. The contributions may be made through teaching within and outside the university, authorship of books and significant publications in technical and professional journals, or research accomplishments to advance engineering methods and management techniques.

Award: The award consists of an engraved plaque.

Qualifications/Method of Selection: The nominee must be a registered professional engineer. To be eligible for consideration, an engineering educator must have a demonstrated long-term record of achievements in promoting engineering within and outside the university. The award is given to recognize lifetime achievements, rather than outstanding accomplishments for a single event. The recipient is selected by the MSPE-PEHE.

Presentation: The award is presented at the MSPE Annual Convention.

Nomination Format: Nominations must be made by a local MSPE Chapter or its local PEE practice division on the prescribed form. At least 2 black & white photos (preferably 5X7's) must be attached.
